MISSION STATEMENT AND ORGANIZATION PROFILE

The mission of the Hispanic Counseling Center is to enhance the strengths of Long Island's families and children through bilingual, bicultural counseling, prevention, vocational, and educational services to enrich their lives, foster economic independence, and nurture dreams for the generations to come.

The Hispanic Counseling Center (HCC) is a multi-service agency with culturally competent, fully bilingual/bicultural treatment and prevention services for chemical dependency, mental illness, and youth and family services. The agency was established in 1977 by the Nassau County Department of Drug and Alcohol Addiction to provide substance abuse services to a growing Latino population in Nassau County. Services are available to anyone, regardless of race, religion, ethnicity, or economic status; no one in need is turned away due to an inability to pay or for lack of insurance. Programs include Mental Health; Chemical Dependency; Youth and Family Services; Child and Family Respite Support Services; Supported Housing for the Mentally III; Domestic Violence Prevention; Teen Drop In Center; and Mental Health Programs for People with HIV/AIDS.

Since its inception, HCC has grown from one program and four staff in a 600 square foot rental office, to ownership of a 38,000 square foot modern facility with 17 programs and a staff of 90 serving over 1,850 clients monthly in 2024.

HCC has the proud distinction of being the only agency in the region which is licensed by both the NY State Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (OASAS) and the NY State Office of Mental Health (OMH) to provide bilingual, bicultural behavioral health services. In 1986 HCC was licensed by OASAS to provide substance abuse treatment, prevention, and education services, and alcohol abuse treatment. In 1990, HCC was licensed by OMH to operate the first bilingual/ bicultural mental health outpatient treatment clinic in Nassau County.

HCC's current budget is just over \$9.3 million, with nearly half of the budget designated for mandated and contracted services as part of New York State funding to the agency, for the provision of mental health and chemical dependency services. Referrals are made to HCC in a variety of ways: the agency works closely with local hospitals and mental health outpatient clinics which refer patients under their care; with Nassau County agencies including the Department of Social Services, Child Protection Services, Family Court, the District Court, and the Probation Department; other social service agencies; local school districts including Freeport, Hempstead, Mineola, Uniondale, and Westbury; with churches and religious institutions, and with attorneys and medical providers.

HCC is well recognized in the Long Island community and throughout New York State. Agency programs demonstrate a high utilization and completion rate; the agency consistently meets funders' expectations; and the agency has historically been re-licensed for the maximum length of time. In addition to being recognized by regulating agencies and other social service providers, HCC is held in high regard by its target audience, the Hispanic and minority community population. As it has been over the past 47 years of service to Long Island, the Hispanic Counseling Center continues to be a beacon of hope for those in need.

Dr. Young is professor and chair of the department of psychiatry at the Zucker School of Medicine and chair and senior vice president for behavioral health at Northwell. He is also chair of the department of psychiatry at the Zucker Hillside Hospital. Previously, he served as vice chair for education in the Department of Psychiatry at the Zucker School of Medicine and the Zucker Hillside Hospital. He also directed the Psychiatry Residency Training Program at ZHH and chaired the Curriculum Committee, which oversees the four-year curriculum at the ZSOM.

Prior to joining Northwell, Dr. Young served as associate professor of psychiatry at UCSF School of Medicine. He held several roles including Associate Director of Residency Training (2005-2012), Director of the Medication Management Clinics (2005-2012), and Chair for the Advanced Studies Committee at the School of Medicine. While at Kaiser Permanente Oakland Medical Center (2012-2013), he was Associate Director for their Longitudinal Integrated Clerkship and an investigator with Kaiser's Behavioral Health Research Initiative.


Dr. Young's research has focused on improving quality and patient safety in the clinical learning workplace. He has made important contributions including regarding: cognitive load, handoffs and patient safety; the 'July Effect'; professional identity formation; and workplace-based assessment in psychiatry.

Dr. Young has held leadership roles in numerous medical education organizations. He is the current President and former Program Chair of the American Association of Directors of Psychiatry Residency Training (AADPRT). He was a member of the National Board of Medical Examiner's (USMLE's) inaugural Patient Safety Test Materials Development Committee and now serves on the Evidence-Based Medicine Interdisciplinary Review Committee.

He received a B.A. (magna cum laude) from Harvard University with a double concentration in Social Studies and the Comparative Study of Religion. He earned a master's degree in Public Policy from the UC Berkeley Goldman School of Public Policy and a PhD in Health Professional Education from Utrecht University in The Netherlands. He obtained his MD from the University of California at San Francisco School of Medicine where he also completed residency training in general adult psychiatry.



66 Being a client at HCC has transcended the conventional therapist-client dynamic; it has become a symbiotic relationship where I not only receive valuable support but also actively incorporate the lessons learned into my own life. The wealth of knowledge and coping mechanisms acquired from therapy sessions has not only enhanced my emotional well-being but has become a resource I draw upon whenever I'm in distress.

GOnce I started taking my sessions seriously, taking every word she said and ingraining it into my mind, I saw genuine progress. My anxiety started to slowly decline, and my anxious tics became minimal. I would wake up and I'd feel okay, which was better than anything else in the years before. It only got better. My communication skills increased drastically, I was able to repair my relationship with my mom and I was able to focus in school. The most important piece of progress for me though, was my confidence. I worked on myself and started practicing deep amounts of self-care and looked out for my own health. I've dropped nearly 40 pounds, cleared up my skin and developed (as cocky as it sounds) an incredible style. I look in the mirror and feel good about myself, and my camera roll has more pictures of me than ever before. This journey has been long but deeply rewarding, and I will only continue to grow.





MONICA MORALES PIX 11 Reporter Host, "Monica Makes It Happen" Program

Monica Morales is a six-time Emmy Award-winning PIX11 News investigative reporter for the weekday evening newscasts and hosts her own TV show called "Monica Makes It Happen." Morales is renowned and beloved throughout New York City for making connections that positively change lives. On her show, Morales honors everyday heroes and celebrities who help their communities thrive, including celebrities and leaders of organizations that provide resources to help her viewers who are in need.

Morales is very active in the Hispanic Community. In 2024, she was elected to New York's National Academy of Arts and Sciences Board of Governors. She was awarded the 100 Hispanic Women Community Service Award. In 2022, Morales received the prestigious Ellis Island Medal of Freedom for her advocacy in immigrant communities and was named an *El Diario Nueva York* Latina of Distinction for her work in the Hispanic community. She also serves on the board of Casa de las Américas at LaGuardia Community College and the Advisory Council of Ellis Island Honors Society.

Morales was profiled by the *Columbia Journalism Review* in 2019 for her special brand of advocacy journalism and is considered one of the only reporters in the nation to focus on public housing in the United States. Morales' Ted Talk on how "Moms Make It Happen" in 2020 focused on the power of women in their communities. Morales says her late mother, Maria Teresa Morales, a Bolivian immigrant to this country who worked three jobs to support her family, is her inspiration every day.

Morales has received a National Emmy for Breaking News, six local Emmys, and an Edward R. Murrow Award for Investigative Series and Reporting. In 2020, Morales won a Continuing Coverage Emmy for her "Monica Makes It Happen" series, and in 2021 and 2022, she was nominated for a Community Service Emmy for her daily coverage of New York City's housing crisis.

In 2018, Morales was invited to the White House. In 2024, she was inducted into Bottomless Closet's Hall of Fame for her support of the nonprofits' work supporting women. In 2023, the Zonta Club of New York, a group active in the United Nations advocating for gender equality, presented Morales with the "Distinguished Woman of the Year Award" for her advocacy.
